



Idaho's Roadmap

The Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP) is Idaho's 25-year roadmap for maintaining and improving our state's transportation system. It provides a statewide vision for how we move people and goods safely and efficiently by highway, local road, transit, rail, water, bicycle, and pedestrian networks.



Needs and Goals

The LRTP is important because it helps Idaho prepare for the future. As the state's population grows and travel needs change, careful long range planning ensures that transportation resources are used wisely. The plan establishes a shared vision for Idaho's transportation system, sets statewide goals, and identifies key trends and challenges that will influence investment decisions. It also ensures that Idaho remains eligible for federal funding by meeting national planning requirements and coordinating with regional and local partners.



Transportation Systems

The LRTP takes a comprehensive look at Idaho's entire transportation system. It examines how to maintain highways and bridges in good condition, improve safety and mobility, and support economic development through efficient freight movement. It also explores how public transportation, walking, and biking can be better integrated into Idaho communities. The plan considers technological advances, such as connected and automated vehicles, and addresses environmental stewardship, sustainability, and system resilience. By identifying both current challenges and future opportunities, the LRTP provides the foundation for smart, coordinated investment decisions.



Partnerships

The LRTP focuses on Idaho's statewide system and provides policy guidance that influences future projects and programs. It does not identify specific construction projects or road designs. Instead, it sets the direction for how ITD invests in transportation infrastructure. Local jurisdictions and Metropolitan Planning Organizations use the LRTP as a framework when developing their own regional and local transportation plans, ensuring that all levels of planning are aligned toward common goals.

October 2025 - January 2026

Survey Inventory Conditions and Needs - Review of the current and future conditions of the transportation system.

Financial Analysis - Develop federal and state revenue forecast to the year 2050.

Develop the Vision, Goals, and Objectives - This will help to refine planning through 2050.

November 2025 - January 2026

Public Stakeholder Outreach - Gather input from stakeholders and the general public on priorities and needs.

January 2026 - March 2026

Scenario Planning - Plan out how future trends and conditions will affect the transportation system.

Summer 2026

Public Stakeholder Outreach - Gather input on the draft plan.
